In Florida, the Special Gathering Program ministers to people in the areas of Titusville, Cocoa, South Brevard, Indian River County, Daytona, Deland, and Jacksonville. It is also located in Colleton County, South Carolina. The largest and oldest program is located in the Cocoa area..

In addition, they do advocacy and teach self-advocacy for their members. They minister to almost 500 mentally-challenged persons and their families. The ministry was started by Rev. Richard Stimson and his wife, Nancy, in 1982.
