Family Promise and Crosswinds

Family Promise is a nonprofit whose mission is to end family homelessness by collaborating with our community to provide families the support and resources they need to put themselves on a path towards long-term stability.

Family Promise of Brevard is addressing the growing crisis by creating innovative housing solutions for all types of families including prevention, shelter and stabilization services, financial coaching, tenancy education, landlord mediation, resource linkage and weekly case management. In 5 years, 1600+ households have been served with 88% still housed after one year. Grace UMC has been a host church for 5 years, housing families 4 times a year, one week at a time, using our facilities to provide meals and shelter.

Crosswinds Youth Services provides a wide range of programs and services for young people and their families. Crosswinds operates Project Safe Place in Brevard County, which is part of a national program offering immediate help to children and teens who have run away, are homeless, on the streets, in an unsafe situation, or just alone or afraid. Crosswinds is committed to providing quality services and has been recognized nationally, regionally, statewide and locally.
