## **January**

Sunday Nights: From Now On - Series From the Gospels on Following Jesus

Sunday School: Grace That Matters - Explores the concept of grace through a variety of lenses like fairness, judgment, and self-forgiveness.

## **February**

Sunday Nights: On Your Own - Series From the Old and New Testament on Godly Friendships

Sunday School: Love In Action - Explores both worldly and personal stereotypes that often keep us from being compassionate toward others, while also learning what can happen when compassion is absent.

## **March**

Sunday Nights: The Making Of - Series From the New Testament on Spiritual Formation

Sunday School: Letting Go - In this series, students reflect on what it means to let go of self, comfort, stuff, status, control, and expectations.

## **April**

Sunday Nights: Invited - From the Gospels and Acts on the Resurrection

Sunday School: Trust - Centers on the lost virtue of trust: the challenges of maintaining it, the consequences of its breach, and the potential for healing and reconciliation.

## **May**

Sunday Nights: In The Shadows - From the Old Testament on Doubting God

Sunday School: Uncharted - Students will explore who they are, their doubts, the baggage they carry in life, and who God calls them to be in the world.
