Grandparents Raising Grandchildren is a nonprofit organization that provides resources to families in our community, improving the stability and quality of life for family members and children. These services include help with Access Florida (food stamps, caregiver funds, and healthcare), support group meetings, parenting classes, referrals for financial and legal empowerment, and support for social engagements and camp experiences. P.E.T. Florida manufactures Personal Energy Transportation for people in impoverished areas who are unable to walk.
